The materials we need

Pour 10g of agar into 330ml of water

Stir the solution until it is completely dissolved

Put the solution into the microwave

Take the solution out and let it cool down for 3 minutes

Pour the solution on the petri dishes and close the lids

After one hour, the solution will solidify

Use a cotton swab to collect the bacteria sample

E.g. you can rub the cotton swab on the door handle

Draw a squiggly line in the agar softly and close the lid

Use a few more clean cotton swabs to collect more samples

Put the petri dishes into a closed box for a week

Here is the result!
